Notes:

- Students may opt to register for any math class lower than their placement.
- If a student feels they have been placed in a math class that is too advanced, they should talk with their instructor or an advisor about changing classes.
- Students who place into Math 152 will not have Math 151 on their college transcript (unless they have earned AP credit). These students should make sure their program of study does not require that they show Math 151 on their transcript.
