If eligible, the waiver pays for most of a student's quarterly class fees for college level classes as well as a small amount of money toward the cost of textbooks (amount varies by quarter).***

****Eligible Fee Waiver students are still required to pay for Material Class Fees, transportation, below 100 level courses & additional textbook expenses.**

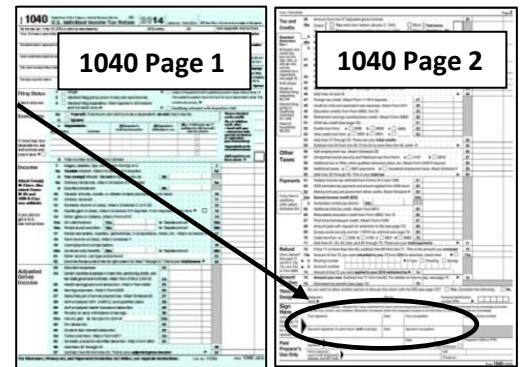
