## HOW TO APPLY

- Applicant must be at least 16 years old, or 15 with a high school diploma or only taking online courses from their home country
- Submit the following documents:
  1. Completed new international student application that can be found online at [edmonds.edu/international/how-to-apply](https://edmonds.edu/international/how-to-apply)
  2. A proof of English proficiency. We accept the following scores:
    - ALPS: Completion of 2 sessions (8 weeks) of level 3
    - CAMBRIDGE: First Certificate Grades A, B, C
    - DUOLINGO: 75 or more
    - EIKEN (Step Eiken): 2A (2150 or higher)
    - ELS Program: Level 109
    - ELTiS: Level 4 (minimum score of 670)
    - FLS: Level 14
    - IELTS: 5.0 (at least 4.5 in each band)
    - Institutional TOEFL: Not accepted
    - ITEP: Level 4
    - Kaplan: Higher Intermediate Level
    - LOEP: 73 or more
    - Pearson Test of English (PTE): Score of 42
    - TOEFL: 54 (Writing 16)*If you don't have a test score, you can take our Institutional test, EXAMITY, online at [edmonds.edu/testing/virtual-testing.html](https://edmonds.edu/testing/virtual-testing.html)*
  3. Current bank statement with a minimum balance of US\$21,901.00 to cover the amount of one year of student expenses.
  4. \$50 non refundable application fee
  5. \$40 I-20 mailing fee (currently waived)
  6. Copy of current passport
  7. Copies of high school transcripts in English (high school program students only)

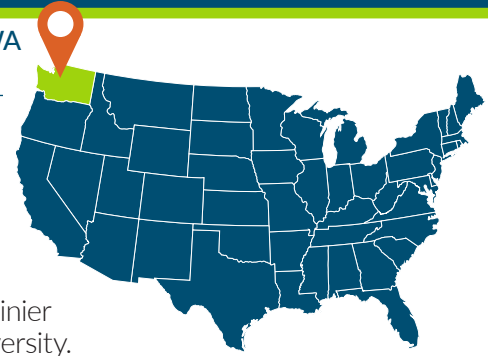
