Ceramics Studio Rules

1. No food or drink: Do not eat or drink in your workspace.
2. Leave things the way you found them or better. Please clean and put away all tools and equipment.
3. Safety before fashion. Please wear closed toed shoes and tie back hair, loose clothing, and or jewelry.
4. Please store your work in the assigned space and clean up the tables and bats after working.
5. Please do not move or disturb other people's artwork. If something needs to be moved, ask an instructor or staff person.
6. Treat other people and staff with respect and adhere to the Edmonds Community College Civility Code of Conduct for Students.
7. Only Edmonds Community College staff can fire, load or unload the kilns unless following a class instruction.
8. Take care of your body and be mindful to back, wrist, and overuse injuries. Protect your back and joints with good posture, frequent breaks, stretching, and bending correctly when lifting.
9. Take care of your lungs by keeping the studio clear of clay dust, clean up scraps and mop up tables and clay dust in the studio. Wear a mask when airborne particles require extra protection for your lungs.
