Two bags of clay, use of pottery studio, glazes and firings are included in class fee.

7/10/2019: Intro to the studio, safety, policies and procedures. Hand out clay and give shelf assignments. Discuss expectations for the class, possible projects and types of firings. Walk through the classroom and point out where everything lives, where to put and find pieces in their various stages. Talk about textured rollers. Think about patterns; color books, doodles, wrapping paper... Use white tissue paper and white board markers to transfer a dot to dot, then apply hot glue. Talk about Raku firing.
