

Watercolor Workshop Supply List : FOR ONLINE WORKSHOPS

Brushes:

(Taklon synthetic or sable, any brand)

- Flat wash – ¾ or 1 inch preferred
- Round #8 or #10
- Round #6 or smaller

Palette:

- Any style white, plastic or porcelain

Paints: *Basic Palette suggested. Winsor&Newton, Prima Marketing, Reeves, Van Gogh, Daniel Smith, Sennelier, Holbein or M. Graham are recommended.*

- Cool Red – Permanent Alizarin Crimson, Quinacridone Magenta
- Warm Red – Cadmium Red Light, Light Red or Vermillion
- Cool Blue – Ultramarine Blue
- Warm Blue – Thalo Blue
- Warm Yellow – Yellow Ochre or Raw Sienna
- Cool Yellow – Light Yellow
- Browns or Earths – Sepia, Burnt Sienna or Quinacridone Sienna

Watercolor Paper:

- 2 or 3 22x30 inch sheets or Arches 140 lb. or 300 Cold Press cut into fourths
- Do not buy the cheap watercolor pads! Please email me to request bringing

Mounting Board:

- Either bring a stiff board clamps, or Incredible Art Board or cardboard to staple mount on your paper.

NOTE: Some Foam Boards and Cardboard mounts will be provided, if you choose not to purchase a mounting board.

Pencils:

- 2H and 6B (Aquarelle Water-based Pencils preferred)
- NOTE: If you cannot find Aquarelle Water-based Pencils, I will bring sufficient pencils to use in workshop. Otherwise, any 2H or 6B pencils will suffice.**

Kneaded Eraser:

- Gray Putty Eraser

This supply list will provide you with plenty of opportunities to explore and practice watercolor painting throughout the workshop, as well as during your time at home or studio for further enjoyment.

MISCILENANEOUS ITEMS TO HAVE ON HAND FOR WATERCOLOR WORKSHOP:

- Viva Paper Towels
- Note paper and blank sketching paper
- Masking Tape for mounting paper (or) Stapler for paper mounting
- Large Water Container (#10 coffee can, or bucket)
- Small towel or sponge for blotting water from brush
- Table Easel if you have one

How to Size (treat) your Watercolor Paper for use before painting to prevent cracks or folds.
