



## **PROJECT HOME ASSOCIATION** **RENT AND HOTEL/MOTEL FUNDING SCHOLARSHIP**

The Project Home Association (PHA) is under the direction of The Center for Student Engagement and Leadership (CSEL), Housing and Residence Life, and the Project Home Ambassador Student Club. Its purpose is to help provide rental/hotel assistance to students in critical need of support towards their housing. Students must be presently attending Edmonds Community College (EdCC). An EdCC student applying for a PHA scholarship must meet the below noted criteria in order to be considered.

### **Eligibility:**

- Must have completed one or more quarters at EdCC
  - Must have an income (financial aid is considered income)
  - Must have a current GPA of 2.0 or higher (or 2.5?)
  - Must currently be taking 3 or more credits
1. Monthly Rent
    - a. If rent is paid monthly – up to a maximum of two months
    - b. If rent is paid weekly – up to a maximum of 10 weeks
    - c. Dollar amount is up to a maximum of \$1600
    - d. Only one month of rent will be paid at a time
    - e. Students are eligible to apply only once per twelve month period
  2. Hotel/Motel voucher up to 14 days/\$600.00 maximum
    - a. Students who utilize a hotel/motel voucher will still be eligible for one month or 4 weeks of rental assistance anytime within a twelve month period.

### **Checklist for Application:**

- Complete and attach the ‘Student Information Release of Records’ (FERPA Form, Enrollment Services)

- Attach your latest unofficial transcript AND current schedule from Edmonds Community College
- Attach your current grade/s from each of your classes signed by your instructor or a printout of grades through Canvas
- Attach your rent invoice or bill from hotel/motel
- Attach a copy of the lease – NA for hotel/motel
- Attach a statement written by the landlord that states all refunds will be returned to Edmonds Community College (if asking for deposit to be paid)
- Bring the application and all mentioned items above to the Housing Office in Rainier Place
